REQUIREMENTS FOR STUDENT ATHLETES

In order to be eligible to participate on Aquinas Academy sports teams, students must be enrolled in the Aquinas Academy homeschool program. All home school students are enrolled under Aquinas school code and accounted for per DOE procedures and will relinquish their individual registration with DEDOE per established procedures.

The student athlete must be studying at least four of the following core subjects: English, math, social studies, science, or foreign language. Senior students must be passing all courses which satisfy an unmet graduation requirement. Those courses will be reviewed, monitored and evaluated by Aquinas staff and a report card will be issued quarterly.

Students must be participating in educational lessons (minimum of three hours of work in core subjects) in order to participate in a practice, scrimmage, or contest on that day. Aquinas defines attendance as a day that the student does schoolwork which qualifies and is recorded as an official school day towards the 180 day state requirement. The student is also considered legally in attendance if they are excused due to a pre-approved commitment, such as court appearance, field trip, college visit, or medical appointment. For a weekend practice, scrimmage, or contest, students must have been legally in attendance at school on Friday. If a student athlete does not meet this requirement, **they are not to participate in the sport activity of that day**. Please contact the appropriate coach to make them aware.

Each student's work is checked throughout the year and the student must be performing satisfactorily in order to participate in sports. Grades are reviewed at least twice per quarterly marking periods; mid-point and end. A grade reporting form will be emailed to you and you are to complete it and return. Forms are available on our web site.

In order to obtain an Aquinas diploma, students will be required to meet the same criteria as on-campus students, 24 credit hours. The home school curriculum will be reviewed, approved and monitored to insure it meets the high standards established in our on-campus curriculum.

Students who participate in sports will not be allowed to withdraw and subsequently return as home school students. They are Aquinas students in all respects in regard to discipline and other policies.

Upon meeting the graduation requirements as outlined in school policy, the home school student will be issued an official Aquinas transcript and diploma.
